The idea behind this festival is simple. Mississippi is host to a wide range of talent, venues and unique spaces. It is one of our most valuable exports. 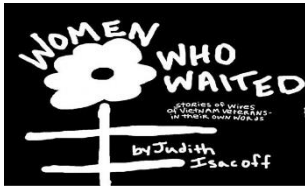

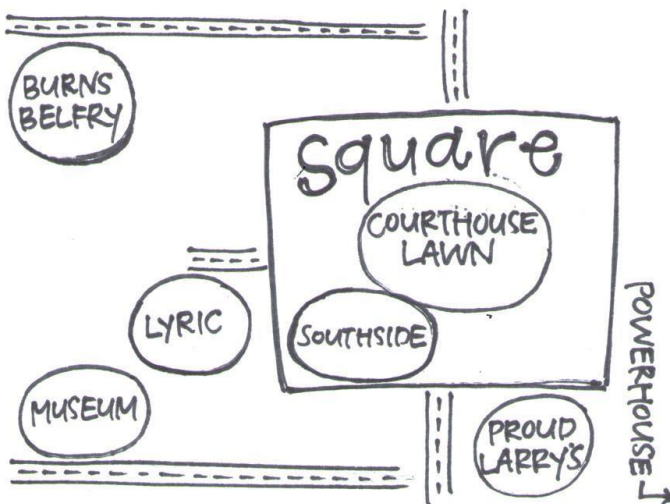
